Centennial Hall and the Four Domes Pavillon

6 University of Wrocław



Walking through the Old Town in the direction of Oder we come to the University of Wrocław. The main building hides the museum of this university, the oldest in the city, the pearl of Wrocław Baroque - Leopoldin's Hall and the musical hall -Oratorium Marianium. It is also worth seeing the Mathematical Tower which used to be an astronomical observatory.
