A main square of Wrocław, where urban life is concentrated around late-Gothic town hall, attracts attention by its renewed townhouses. Close neighbourhood of town hall is also worth visiting because of places such as Salt square, famous Świdnicka street or cobblet alley Jatki, where from the XII century meat from the municipal slaughterhouse was sold. An original monument In Memory of Animals for Slaughter reminds about it.

ZOO and Africarium

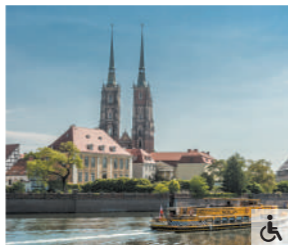

It is the oldest part of Wrocław. Architectural sights worth seeing include: Saint Cross church and the Cathedral of John the Baptist with a viewpoint on the tower. In Archdiocesan Museum it is necessary to see Henryk's Book containing the first sentence written in Polish – a relic listed on the UNESCO 'Memory of the World'.

Panorama of Ractawice



The panoramic painting, depicting the Battle of Ractawice, painted on 15 x 114 m canvas by Jan Styka and Wojciech Kossak, is located in specially built rotunda. The exceptional way of presentation of this work completed in 1894 takes the viewer into the centre of battle. The ticket to Panorama Ractawicka lets you also visit the National Museum and the Ethnographic Museum.

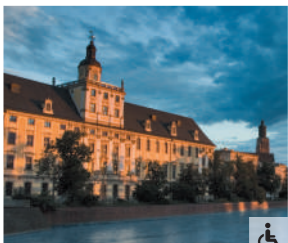

Kolejkowo

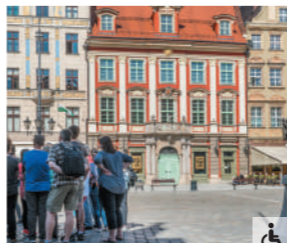

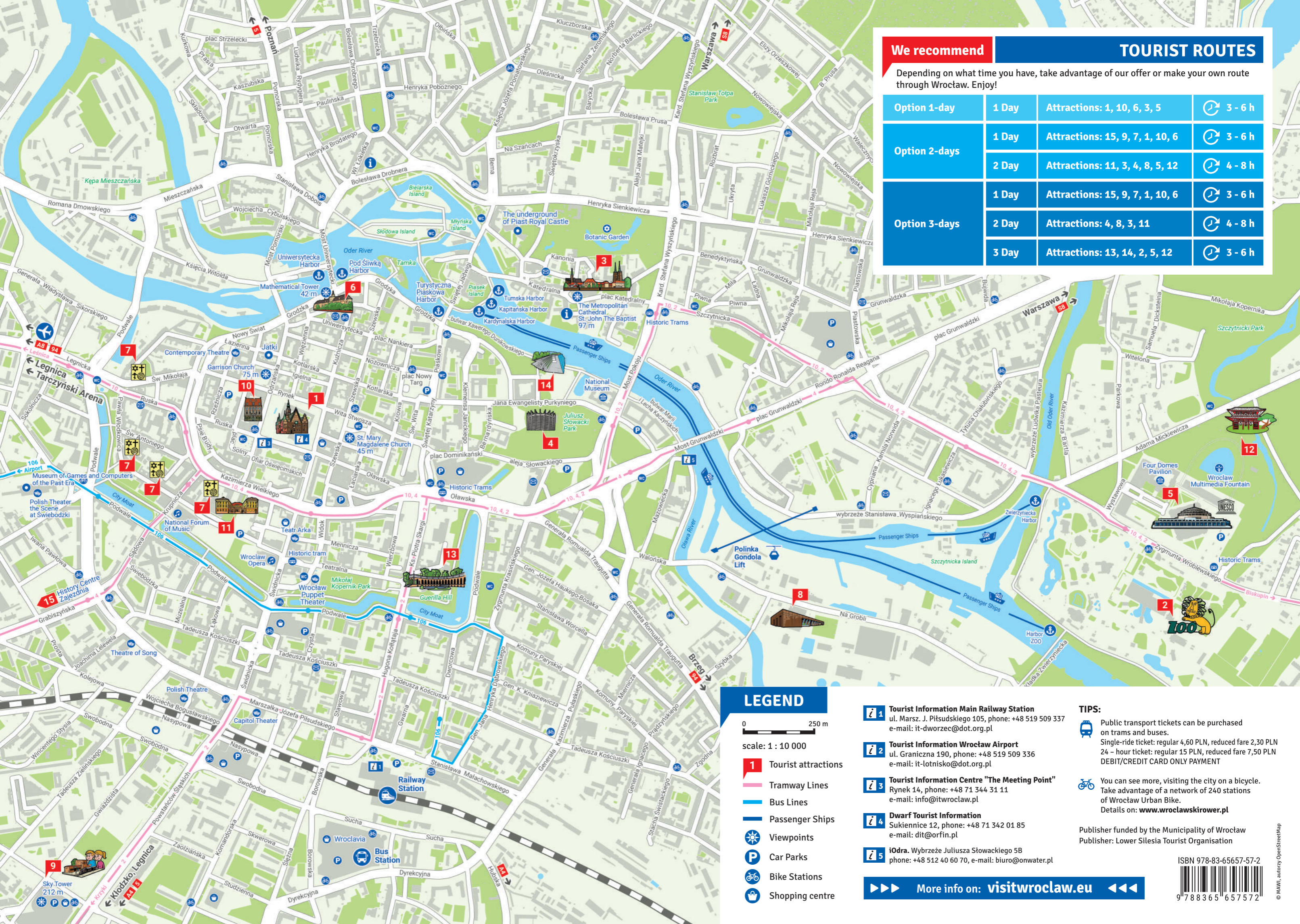
